Projects that are limited to earth disturbance for the GP activity only are not required to pay additional E&S Review Fees. Entities (municipalities, municipal authorities, county, state and federal governments) that are exempt from paying the Chapter 105 Application Fees are required to pay a \$25 E&S Plan Review Fee. Projects that involve earth disturbance in addition to the GP activity are required to pay the E&S Review Fee according to the fee schedule in item “A” above.
