# **ACCEPTABLE PAPER:**

Corrugated cardboard

Paper board such as cereal boxes, six pack holders, cake mixes, etc.

Catalogs, magazines, junk mail, office paper, construction paper, brown paper Amazon mailers, newspapers with inserts, phone books, cards, folders, envelopes

#### **ACCEPTABLE PLASTIC:**

#1 PETE plastic bottles (water, pop, juice, peanut butter, energy drinks, etc.) #1 PETE clamshells and trays (clear only) #2 HPDE plastic bottles (detergent, milk, shampoo, vinegar, etc.) #5 PP (Cool Whip, yogurt, sour cream, any item, regardless of shape or size, that has a #5 PP recycling symbol on it)

#### **ACCEPTABLE CANS:**

Aluminum beverage cans, pet food cans, tinned fish cans, steel cans for soups, vegetables, beans, etc. Aluminum foil and aluminum bakeware, aerosol cans. PLEASE NO METAL SCRAP!

#### **ACCEPTABLE GLASS:**

Food and beverage bottles and jars ONLY. No ceramics, dishes, mugs, drinking glasses, bakeware, window glass, candle glass, or any other item made of glass.
