#### Elk County Industrial Development Authority's Guaranteed Revenue Refunding Bonds - Series of 2012

The Elk County Industrial Development Authority issued Guaranteed Revenue Bonds refunding Series of 2012 in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,945,000. In conjunction with the issuance of the bonds, the Authority entered into a loan agreement with North Central Enterprise, Inc. to assist in the financing of a project for the following: the current refunding of the Authority's Guaranteed Revenue Bonds, Series of 2006 which were issued to advance refund the Authority's Guaranteed Revenue Bonds series of 2002 which financed the acquisition and construction of a maintenance/office facility, the acquisition of land and a building for use as an education and training facility and public infrastructure improvements to an industrial complex, fund a debt service reserve fund, fund a capital reserve fund, and pay the costs of issuing the bonds by the Authority.

The County, pursuant to a guaranty agreement, has guaranteed the principal and interest and has entered into a reimbursement agreement with North Central Enterprises, Inc. to reimburse the County for any required payment by the County as guaranteed and any reasonable changes and expenses related to the guaranty agreement. The bonds are scheduled to mature at various times through October 1, 2022 and bear interest at 0.80 percent to 3.00 percent. The aggregate annual debt service requirements are as follows:

Under the provisions of the Act of April 27, 1925, PL 324, the Commonwealth pays this allotment to the County of Elk to be disbursed to townships and schools where the Allegheny National Forest is situated. These funds are to be used for schools and roads.

The County must divide the allotment, 75% for schools; 25% for roads, unless the citizens of the township have voted for a 50-50 split. In Elk County, the citizens of all townships have voted for a 50-50 split of the National Forest Allotments between the schools and roads. The amount of the distribution is determined by the acreage of National Forest land in each township.
